Ownership/durability

Ensuring Project sustainability of Outputs and deliverables

Ongoing Support & Maintenance

When a project develops outputs (e.g., digital platforms, tools, or systems) that require ongoing use and upkeep, it's needed to address post-project responsibilities.

Financial & Institutional Support

Establish clear accountability for financial and institutional support after project conclusion.

Sustainability and Long-term impact

Ensuring proper support guarantees the sustainability and long-term impact of the project.

Lasting effects/dissemination

Deliverables available for dissemination

Long-Term Availability of Outputs

Ensure that outputs and deliverables are accessible to relevant target groups .

Lasting Effect

Make sure that these resources are actively used to create a lasting impact on the territory or community.

Transferability

Transfer of project outputs and deliverables

Adaptation & further development

Outputs and deliverables can be adapted or enhanced to meet the needs of additional target groups or be rolled out in other territories beyond the original partnership.

Ensuring Awareness

Communication and capitalisation activities will ensure that relevant groups are informed about the availability and potential uses of these outputs and deliverables.
