

## Durable plaques

### General requirements

According to Article 36, point 4. of the European Territorial Cooperation (Interreg) Regulation (EU) 2021/1059, durable plaques must be set up when the operation involves a **physical investment** or the **purchase of equipment**, and the **total cost of the operation exceeds EUR 100 000**.

**The use of Programme's plaque template is compulsory and cannot be modified.**

Moreover, the plaque must:

- be installed as soon as the physical implementation starts or purchased equipment is installed
- be placed next to the location where the operation takes place, as they must be readily visible to the public
- be made of durable and weatherproof material in case of outdoor use
- have a minimum size of A2

### Plaques elements

- **Project Acronym**
- **Project website**

With the reference to the website, you can provide further information about the project. Make sure that the information on the website stays up-to-date in the long-run.

- **Programme Logo**

Within these templates the Programme logo / EU emblem is to be placed on the top left corner.

- **Priority symbol**
- **Project logo**

Within these templates, as per the Regulation and Programme Manual, if other logos are displayed in addition to the Union emblem (flag), the Union emblem shall have at least the same size as the biggest of the other logos.

- **Project description**

The description should not exceed 400 characters. Plain and clear language is recommended, therefore avoiding the use of acronyms, jargon and/or repetition. A good project description explains the projects' objective(s) in a meaningful and simple manner to the public.

- **QR code**

Programme website's QR code

- **ERDF Funding**
- **Total budget**
